## MUST HAVE BIBLE STUDY PRINTABLE

Get deeper into God's word by breaking down scripture. When you do this, you get a better understanding of God's word and how you can implement God's wisdom and lessons into your life.

2 Timothy 2:15-17 (TPT) tells us:

"Always be eager to present yourself before God as a perfect and mature minister, without shame, as one who **correctly explains the Word of Truth.**"

By breaking down scripture, you are not only learn more and grow in your own spiritual walk, but you will also be able to correctly explain God's word with others.

## THE PROCESS OF BREAKING DOWN A PASSAGE:

- 1) **Pray** & ask God to help you understand the scriptures you are about to read and ask Him for a specific word through fresh personal revelation. Open your heart and allow Him to speak to you thorugh His Word.
- 2) Know something about the over all book in which the passage appears & It's over all context. Is it the old or new testament? Does it have to do with Law, History, Literature, Prophecy or Biography? You may need to consider more than just the single passage to find out more about the context of that scripture.
- 3) **Ask Questions and dig deeper.** You will find all of the questions in the worksheet to help you flesh out the scripture.
- 4) Think about how you can implement these new lessons in your life.
